The Peachtree City Airport Authority (PCAA) is a separate governmental agency that owns and operates Atlanta Regional Airport – Falcon Field. The Airport Authority is comprised of five members appointed to five-year terms. Meetings are held the second Thursday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at the Aviation Center, 7 Falcon Drive. Members are required to attend a minimum of eighty percent (80%) of all meetings.

An applicant must be a legal resident of the State of Georgia, have been a resident of Peachtree City for at least six months prior to the date the application is submitted, and be eligible to vote in Peachtree City Municipal elections. Elected officials of any governmental jurisdiction in the County and City employees are not eligible for appointment.
